


## Secondary Summer School 2014 Registration Information for TDSB Students

Registration for summer school is now online through e-Reg.

Step 1: Go to the TDSB summer school website at [www.creditprograms.ca](http://www.creditprograms.ca) and click on the link for TDSB students. The following screen will appear.

Step 2. Browse the course options and select the course you are interested in taking. You may select a maximum of two courses. Submit your course request.

Step 3. Check your email for next steps. If you are under 18 years of age, you will need to print the parent consent form sent with the email confirming your course request.

Step 4. See your guidance counsellor. Remember to take your consent form if you are under 18.

Step 5. Your guidance counsellor will discuss your course request with you. The guidance counsellor can approve or deny the request. When the request is approved by the counsellor, you will be enroll in the course if there is space. If there is no space, you will be placed on the waiting list. You will receive an email telling you that you are enrolled in the course or on the waiting list.
