In grade 12, Advanced Placement (AP) courses are available in, Calculus, Data Management, Computer Programming and Economics.

AP exams are also available in Chemistry, Biology, and Physics.

Bright, enthusiastic and academically strong students are placed in classes with dedicated and engaging teachers to create dynamic, competitive and cooperative learning environments. Successful graduates of the program receive a certificate and a reference letter recognizing their achievements. MaCS students are school leaders and innovators that contribute greatly to school life.
